### 2 Forms & Information

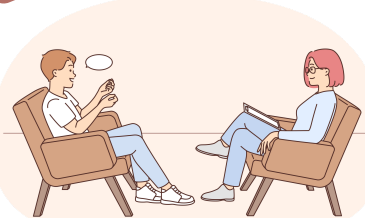
We'll email you forms to help us understand your experiences, strengths and support needs.

### 3 90 Minute Intake Appointment & Planning

Your psychologist will learn about your history, strengths, goals and support needs to create an individualised assessment plan.



- Explore strengths and challenges
- Discuss assessment goals
- Create personalised assessment plan
- Confirm assessment pathway ie/ ADHD/Autism only, Combined ADHD & Autism, Full Neurodevelopmental Profile

### 4 Assessment Appointments
